#### **General Volunteer Information**

- Please sign in with Olivia at Hotel Ballast so she can direct you to your designated area
- Parking is limited, but there are spaces on the street and in the parking deck across the street.
- If your shift permits, please feel free to look around at all the designers' great work!
- Friday night's VIP PREVIEW PARTY is business casual attire – please dress accordingly

Closed-toe shoes, slacks, dress shirts, etc.

- Saturday's event is casual attire if you have a Habitat shirt, we encourage you to wear it!
- Please note that volunteers are not permitted to drink alcohol before or during a volunteer shift.

# **Volunteer Roles**

#### Wall Assembly/Painting: March 4-7 (10am-3pm), March 12 (9am-12pm)

- Painting walls (March 4-7)
- Assemble walls at Hotel Ballast (Heavy Lifting) (Wednesday, March 12)

#### Set-Up Assistants/Unloaders: Mar 12 (1-5pm) & Mar 13 (8:30am-12pm) (1-4:30 pm)

- Unload & build walls—heavy lifting may be required (Wednesday)
- Unload Designer Items & Help Set-Up (Thursday)
- Assist with Designer Set-Up as needed (Thursday)

## Check-Out/Cashier Assistants: Mar 14 (5:00pm-9pm) & Mar 15 (8:15am-2pm)

- There will be 8 total check-out stations (1 per every 2 booths)
- Assist customers in their purchases
- Assist ReStore cashiers as needed
- Place a "Sold" tag on all sold items Make sure sold tag is visible

• Assist with needs during the event (serve as floater if needed)

#### **Registration & Ticket Sales:** Mar 14 (5:00pm-8:30pm) & Mar 15 (8:15am-12:30pm)

Two Roles:

#### 1) Ticket Sales Assistant (more technologically involved)

- Sell tickets to those who need them
- Tickets can be purchased with cash or debit/credit card
- **Cash**: There will be a cashbox on the table with change available if you need it
- Credit Card: Use card reader

#### 2) Ticket List Registration

Check-in those with tickets

#### For people who bought tickets in ADVANCE:

- Look up their name on the registration list, check it off the list
- If they have a confirmation email available, please still check off name on the list

#### For people who are BUYING tickets there:

- $\circ$  \$55 each at the door for tickets on Friday's VIP night
- \$5 each to the general public on Saturday (kids under 12 are free)

#### Food Server: Mar 14 (5pm-9pm)

- Replenishing/portioning food on the buffet
  - Make sure to only do **one** scoop/serving per patron
- Throwing away empty cups/plates
- Assist catering company with clean-up
- Try to wear black pants, a white shirt, and closed-toe shoes

#### Breakdown Cleaners/Lifters: Mar 15 (1:30pm-3:30pm & 3:30pm-5:30pm)

#### • Break-down Vignettes (1:30pm-3:00pm)

- Assist customers in loading purchased items into their cars
- Separate Pickup & Delivery items
- Help to pack unsold items to be sent to ReStore
- Load unsold items left over on the trucks


#### • Lifters (3:30pm-5:30pm)

- $\circ$  Breakdown walls
- Load walls onto trucks
- Heavy Lifting required.

#### Parking/Gate Attendant Mar 15 (12:30pm-5:00pm)

 Help find available parking and use provided key card to scan customers in to pick up purchased items
